

Seal Island Harbour

Description:

The construction of the Seal Island Bridge over the Seal Reefs created a sheltered harbour behind the causeway extending from the north shore, with good protection from the prevailing winds in the channel. Deep water and rapidly changing depths generally preclude anchoring in this area. However, a marina now exists with a wharf and floating dock, and a number of moorings. This is an ideal location to await passage through the bridge and Great Bras d'Or Narrows

Navigation:

Enter and leave on the west side of Seal Island, favouring the western shore to avoid the reef extending from Seal Island
