

Shunacadie & Black Point

Description:

Shunacadie (sometimes spelled 'Shenacadie') is 5 miles due east of Maskells Harbour. The name 'Shunacadie' is from a Mi'kmaq word meaning "a place of cranberries".

The two coves afford limited protection as they are open to the north.

The western cove, inside Black Point, has one of the finest sand beaches on the lakes, with 6 feet of water close to the beach on the western shore.
