3,000 open ocean miles

2 x deliveries from Auckland/Opua to Port Vila; 1,200-1,300 nm each.

First watchkeeper on a 60' Catamaran (SV South Sea Vagabond)

500 nm, Fiji to Port Vila on a 36' double-ender (SV Tamara)

700+ nm coastal deliveries on 25-30' racing yachts

Lyttelton to Picton and back (East Coast South Island NZ)

Russell, Auckland, Coromandel, Bay of Plenty (East Coast North Island NZ)

5 years of club racing in Auckland, Lyttelton, Akaroa, Marlborough Sounds and Cook Strait

Short handed and fully crewed on 25-30' racing yachts
